CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

All classes need a minimum of 4 -6 participants.

***NEW* BEGINNER SIGN LANGUAGE:** (ages 8-adult) Join us to learn some ASL, understanding of deaf culture, beginner conversation and some worship!

***NEW* SPONTANEITY (SONGWRITING/POETRY/FREE WORSHIP):** (ages 10 - adult) Do you want to be able to write lyrics on the spot? Improve your freestyle singing? Then this is the class for you. Using the analysis of spontaneous worship leading, free poetry, and freestyle rap, we will achieve quality results on the spot. This will be a hands on class, working with our peers to become better lyricists and improve our SPONTANEITY!

STRING ORCHESTRA ENSEMBLE: (ages 7-adult) is for violin, viola, cello, and upright bass players. At least 1 year of prior playing experience is preferred, however, exceptions for younger or less experienced players will be considered on an individual basis. Younger students must also maintain the ability to focus for a 40 min class/rehearsal. In this ensemble, you will learn to play in both traditional classical settings as well as modern worship settings.

COMMUNITY CHOIR: (ages 10 - adult) In this class, students will have the opportunity to sing with a group of other musicians while learning a variety of repertoire. We will learn how to sing more than one part at the same time (with more than one voice to a part). Students will experience harmony, solfège, fun ear training games, and exercises all while getting to use their voice to be part of a bigger, unified sound!

MUSIC & MOVEMENT: KIDS CHOIR: (ages 6-9) is a class where we will experience the fun of exploring music through movement. Young singers get to be a part of a choir while adding in motions that allow them to feel the music in a deeper way. We will be adding in props such as musical scarves and small percussion instruments.

ART I CLASS: (ages 10 - adult) Classes will cover sketching techniques for still life and landscapes, introduce beginners to watercolors, and will culminate in a final project of the student's choosing. This is a great introduction to learning to see as a sketch artist and exploring watercolors. No previous experience is required, but a willingness to make lots of mistakes and learn from them is highly recommended! :)

ART 4 KIDS (ages 6-9) In class kids will get to explore a variety of mediums and fun projects that will help to develop an artist's eye and inspiration. Foundational Art skills of sketching and the color wheel will be mixed into the fun! (Supply list will be given after registration, or pay an additional \$10 to use classroom supplies)

UKULELE ENSEMBLE CLASS: (recommended ages 9 - adult) Students will learn the basic elements of music that will allow them to jam out on their ukuleles to a variety of songs. We will learn (or review) chords, picking patterns, tablature, duets, and more. All levels are welcome to join!

BREAKDANCE CLASS: (recommended ages 12 - adult) Welcome to Breaking! You are now going to learn how to break and how to become a “breaker”, “b-boy” (break-boy) or “b-girl” (break-girl).

After we learn some moves we will start a “cypher”, which is a circle of people practicing freestyle breaking. We learn how to improve and how to have more freedom with our breaking by doing these turn-taking circles.

Breaking is part of Hip-Hop culture, “Hip” meaning having intelligence and “Hop” meaning movement.

SPANISH IMMERSION CLASS: (ages 7 - adult) This class is geared so that you will only rely on Spanish and not your first language. Whether you are a new beginner or if you're an intermediate student that needs to practice their speaking and listening skills, this course is recommended for you!
